### 131.01 RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY FEE WAIVER.

(a) The Mayor is hereby authorized to waive recreational activity fees established by Council for the purpose of promoting and enhancing civic pride and public awareness of the recreational activities of the City. (Ord. 148-76. Passed 12-27-76.)

(b) The Mayor shall report to Council at the first legislative meeting of the

month, the waiver of fees and the nature of the activities for which fees were waived for the preceding calendar month.

**131.02 CODIFIED CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

The Mayor shall designate certain employees of the City of Rocky River to perform as Codified Code Enforcement Officers and to serve at the pleasure and direction of the Mayor in this capacity.
