1341.01 BUILDING DEFINED.

"Building", for the purpose of this Chapter, shall mean a building over one (1) story in height wherein residence units to be used as such are provided for or exist on the upper floor or floors.

1341.02 OUTSIDE UNENCLOSED STAIRWAYS PROHIBITED.

No person shall erect or construct any steps or stairway as a part of and on the outside of a building in the City, which steps or stairway are used or intended to be used as a means of entrance to and exit from the upper stories of such building thereof, unless such steps or stairway are enclosed and not exposed to the weather.

1341.03 ENFORCEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION.

The Building Commissioner is designated as the administering officer to enforce the provisions of this Chapter.

1341.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense. Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a fourth degree misdemeanor for the second offense or subsequent offenses.
