721.01 INSPECTION STAMP REQUIRED.

No person shall sell, offer for sale or have in his possession any meat or meat food products derived from cattle, sheep, swine, goats or horses unless:

(a) In the case of meat, it shall bear on each part the inspection stamp of the USDA or the inspection stamp of some other governmental agency.

(b) In the case of meat products, such as meat loaf, wieners, sausage and similar products, the inspection legend shall appear on the individual packages or on labels, tags or on sufficient individual pieces so as to adequately establish the fact that it is an acceptably inspected product.

721.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense. Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a fourth degree misdemeanor for the second offense or subsequent offenses.
