953.01 DEFINITIONS.

For the purpose of this Chapter, the following definitions shall apply:

(a) "Tot" means a person 3 to 5 years of age.

(b) "Student" means a person eighteen (18) years of age or under, or a person enrolled in the current semester of an elementary, junior or senior high school as a full-time student.

(c) "Adult" means a person nineteen (19) year of age or older, but does not include a person enrolled for the current semester as a full-time student in a senior high school.

(d) "Resident" means a person whose legal residence is in the City of Rocky River.

(e) "Non-resident" means a person whose legal residence is outside the City of Rocky River. (Ord. No. 81-95. Passed 7/10/95)

(f) "Resident group" means fifty percent (50%) or more being residents of the City of Rocky River. (Ord. No. 81-95. Passed 7/10/95.)

953.02 FEES.

Commencing on January 1, 2010, and thereafter until further order of Council, the following rates shall be charged for admission to the Rocky River Municipal Ice Skating Rink.

953.03 SCHOOLS, BOARD OF EDUCATION USE.

(a) For regular scheduled high school hockey games, the City shall collect an admission from all spectators according to the schedule in Section 953.02(J). The gate receipts collected at these times shall be considered as compensation for all ice time for the Rocky River High School Team.

(b) Gym classes from any or all Rocky River schools may use the Rocky River Recreation Center at no charge provided that.

1. Open time is available.
2. The school furnishes proper supervision.
3. Time will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
