

CHAPTER 954
Civic Center Recreation Facilities

954.01 Fees.

Commencing on January 1, 2010 and thereafter, until further order of the City Council, the following fees shall be charged for use of the Civic Center Recreation Facilities:

* FOR WALKING TRACK ONLY – Availability may be restricted according to capacity limitations during peak hours. Track membership does not include use of cardio vascular equipment or member discounts of programs.

* Employees of the City of Rocky River (both full time and part time) may purchase memberships at the resident rate for themselves and family members.

- Part time employees must average at least 10 hours per week
- Includes employees of the Municipal Court and Wastewater Treatment Plant

* Wellness Program

- Employees who choose to participate in the Wellness Program will be eligible for a reduction of their membership renewal of up to 100%
- Membership reductions will be for the employee only and does not extend to other family members
- Amount of reduction will be based on a point system approved by the Mayor in cooperation with the Fitness Manager

- 10% discount on outdoor pool passes
- Children 5 and up must be members or pay daily admission
- Children 4 and under are free – entitled to member discount on classes, free admission to Squeaky Sneakers and Indoor Playground if parent has membership
