

DODGEBALL 2012 FAQs

How do I register a team? Pick up a registration form at the Civic Center or download and print from www.rrcity.com/rec. Pay the \$200 team fee with one form of payment (cash, check or credit card). One payment per team—individual payments not accepted.

How many people can be on a team? There is NO minimum, but there can be NO MORE THAN 10 players per team.

Can I substitute players? Absolutely NOT. Once the league has started, NO roster changes or substitutions are permitted for ANY REASON (this includes broken bones, illness, etc.). The roster you turn in is final.

I am in 6th grade but have a friend in 7th grade. Can I put them on my team? YES. You may register a team with different grade level players. However if you have more than one older player on your team, you must register in the next highest division (i.e. a 6th grade team with more than one 7th grader must register in the 7th grade division).

Do I have to wear my team shirt every week? YES. If you wish to play, you MUST wear your team shirt to every game. This eliminates cheating.

I am a high school student. Can I play on a middle school team? NO. There are two divisions at the high school level-upperclass and underclass. NO high school student may play on a middle school team.

I am a middle school student. Can I play on a high school team? NO. High school students play at a higher, more aggressive level.

Do all players have to be River residents? NO. They must, however, attend Rocky River schools.

I do not have a team to play on, but want to participate. What can I do? You can register as an individual player and IF we get enough interest, we will put together a team.

Students are responsible for putting together their own teams. All disputes regarding participants need to be settled prior to registration. This program was created by students in 2001 and has maintained the original integrity over the past ten years. NONE of the above rules will be broken.
