

Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting
Meeting Minutes
June 8th, 2023

- **Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 7:51am. The meeting was held in person in the Club Room in Memorial Hall. Members Present: Diana Leitch, Dr. Jim Ulchaker, Joe Roszak, and Amy Massad. Also present: Bob Holub, Krissie Miller and Erica Garland.
- **Approval of Minutes:** Minutes from May 11th, 2023 were approved as submitted. Joe Roszak motioned and Amy Massad 2nd.

- **Civic Center Report:**
 - Studio 2 is complete. New squat rack has been put in and the larger one was moved into the track alcove, however the walking directions are causing issues for the track runners and walkers. The free weight area has expanded. All Spring Sports are over. Summer sports have started: baseball, summer hoops, camps, volleyball, Day camp is starting Monday. Dare graduation is today for the 5th graders held here in the gym along with a pool party. Outdoor pool opens tomorrow, the 9th. Swim lessons start on Monday. Currently we are only short about 12 lifeguards.
 - Family Health and Fitness Day- a National Parks and Recreation Association day about getting families out at the parks and participating in fun, healthy activities. We will have Cleveland Water there. Some free exercise demo classes, an inflatable obstacle course, basketball competitions and the Kona Ice truck. Also have some raffle prizes to give away. Everyone who comes gets a ticket. Prizes were purchased through Meijer's gift card donation.
 - Pickle Ball League will go in the newsletter this week for a start next month.
- **Director's Report:**
 - Parks: Martin and Morley had fields cut out (diamonds) and a back stop put in. Merry Go Round at City Hall Park has been removed, new one will be installed in late fall.
 - Pool is filled and at 76 degrees currently and should be up to 80 tomorrow for opening. Lake Road Market is good to open the concession stand and host day camp lunches.
 - Day Camp will be opening up spots on a weekly basis, depending on staff and current number of campers.
 - Recreation U: training for all staff, levels 100-500 (30-45 minute classes) from our mission, safety procedures, cpr training, and position specific classes) Michelle and Daniel started the program. Each completed level, staff receives some type of swag, after level 500 they receive their staff shirt and are ready to start work.
 - Bradstreet Landing: may open tomorrow. Pier is complete but not accessible, greenspace is the next phase.
