

ART CLASSES

Beginning Pottery: Students of all levels are welcome to develop new skills or expand upon their knowledge with individual instruction. Students new to working with clay will develop hand-building skills such as pinch pot method, slab building and coiling through fun and interesting projects. Students will continue to refine skills by creating new forms and using surface design and glazing techniques.

Intermediate/Advanced Pottery: Experienced students will expand upon their knowledge of ceramics and will receive individualized instruction to create new projects.

Watercolor Painting: Watercolor instruction for intermediate skill levels. Students bring their own reference material.

Drawing More Than The Basics: This class is for those who have taken Intro to Drawing or who have good drawing skills and would like to refine and expand them. This class will explore drawing with charcoal, pencil, and pen through a variety of subjects. Methods focus on drawing techniques, creating good compositions and the use of a variety of materials.

Colored Pencil: Colored pencils can do so much more than just filling in spaces on a coloring page. They are a versatile tool and medium

once you know their secrets. In this class, you learn how to achieve soft blends and fades, texturing effects, splattering, lifting and a few more. You will also learn about color layering, paper considerations and solvents to use with your pencils to take yourself beyond coloring to creating.

Oil & Acrylics: Paint is a fun and relaxing activity where you can explore the world around you or let your imagination and creativity soar. Oils and acrylics are wonderful mediums to paint with and easy to learn. If you are new to painting or have a few paintings under your belt, this is geared for all levels. Students will work with guided projects consisting of fun and quirky still life, interesting landscapes, and more!

Nature Thru Watercolor: Enjoy exploring nature through watercolor painting scenes of birds, animals, landscapes and flowers. This class is open to all levels with demonstrations on the use of watercolors through live demonstrations and individual instruction of a variety of techniques and how to apply them to paintings. More advanced students will get a chance to brush up on their basic skills and expand them with more challenging subjects.

Beginning Zentangle Art: For those with no experience. A Zentangle is a miniature abstract work of art created by a collection of patterns. It is typically done on a small paper tile using a pencil and a black pen.
