Through The Eyes Of The Artist: Is an artistic biography lecture series that offers an exclusive view into the remarkable lives and times of our favorite artists. You'll have the opportunity to learn about artists you may not know now, but will never forget. Each presentation is enhanced with music, print and images to help tell the artist's story. A different artist is featured every month.

Trivia: Trivia is a type of game in which players (who can play individually or in a team) are asked questions about different topics and they have to get as many correct answers as possible.
