## **Position Overview**:

Under the general supervision of the Aquatics and Safety Manager, the Aquatic Safety Supervisor will be responsible for the planning, scheduling, and supervising Aquatic staff. The Aquatic Safety Supervisor will assist in all events/activities within the department and will work directly with the public. The work is performed in both an indoor and outdoor pool facility. The employee may be exposed to adverse weather conditions as well as humidity, ultraviolet rays, pool chemicals and chlorinated water.

#### **Duties**:

## 1. Staff Management

- Work a flexible schedule to cover any supervisor or lifeguarding shift openings (afternoon, evening and weekends) \*
- Hire, train, schedule in When to Work and supervise Aquatic Supervisors and lifeguards\*
- Recruit staff and build retention\*
- Interact and communicate effectively with staff and patrons\*
- Schedule and conduct thorough in-services and audits with the help of LGI's \*
- Assist and teach Recreation University trainings\*
- Assist with rentals, camp and birthday parties as needed\*
- Enforces facility policies, rules and regulations\*

# 2. Administrative Responsibilities

- Plan and organize all pool special events, lifeguard Olympics, lifeguard appreciation day and end of season staff event \*
- Inventory and pass out staff uniforms\*
- Weekly inventory and restock of all recreation first aid supplies, crash bags and safety equipment\*
- Assist in creating the monthly pool schedule\*
- Assist in creating and monitoring the deck hand daily cleaning list for the outdoor pool\*
- Daily cleaning and shutdown / opening schedules for indoor and outdoor pools\*
- Monitors and tests for pool water quality. Maintains records of tests\*
- Prepares & completes attendance records, county weekly pool / spa operation report, accident reports, supervisor reports, incident reports, evaluation reports and deposit reports as required\*
