SUMMARY OF MAJOR DUTIES:

Under the supervision of the Recreation Facilities Coordinator and/or Field Maintenance Crew Leader, the Seasonal Laborer will assist in upkeep and maintenance of the Outdoor Municipal Pool, Ten City Parks and the Recreation Complex. The Seasonal Laborer will be responsible for the safety and cleanliness of facility restrooms, grounds and equipment.

SUMMARY OF REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be willing to assist with pool operations, park operations and ice rink facility upkeep. Must have an ability to work with the public as needed, as well as the ability to multitask work. Must be a minimum of 18 years old to operate some equipment/city vehicles.

SUMMARY OF EQUIPMENT USED:

General cleaning equipment, field upkeep/management tools, power tools, ladders, pool operation equipment, office equipment, etc.

SUMMARY OF WORK ENVIRONMENT:

The work is performed in a typical parks & recreation environment where the employee may be exposed to adverse environmental conditions such as heat and rain. May be exposed to heights for maintenance function of the position. May be required to enter the pool for certain tasks. Early mornings, evenings and weekend work required.

MAJOR DUTIES AND TASKS:

1. Parks & Grounds 49%

- Ensure all park restrooms are safe and clean
- Stock and ensure operation of all park sanitizers, paper products, etc.
- Remove trash and debris from park trash/recycle bins and green spaces
- Performs light duty maintenance and repairs as required
- Help implement safety procedures and proper signage
- Assist in litter and trash removal from grounds on a daily basis
- Weeding, landscaping and other
- Report any necessary repairs to Recreation Facilities Coordinator

2. Outdoor Pool & Ice Rink Facility
