Position Overview:

Under the general supervision of the Aquatics Supervisor, the Water Safety Instructor teaches American Red Cross Learn-to-Swim and safety programs to adults and children. The Water Safety Instructor also prepares lesson plans, takes class attendance, and completes progress reports. The Water Safety Instructor works with aquatic exercise equipment, including, but not limited to kickboards, fins, pull buoy, lifejackets, and hand paddles. The work is performed in both an indoor and outdoor pool facility. The employee may be exposed to adverse weather conditions as well as humidity, ultra-violet rays, pool chemicals and chlorinated water.

- Prepares lesson plans, takes class attendance, completes progress reports*
- Maintains a safe and enjoyable environment in and around the pool area*
